National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

"Pearl Harbor Day, is observed annually in the United States on December 7, to remember and honor the 2,403 Americans who were killed in the Japanese surprise attack on Pearl Harbor in Hawaii, which led to the United States declaring war on Japan the next day and thus entering World War II.

"The attack on December 7, 1941 sank four U.S. Navy battleships and damaged four others. It also damaged three cruisers, three destroyers, and one minelayer. Aircraft losses were 188 destroyed and 159 damaged."

"On Pearl Harbor Day, the American flag should be flown at half-staff until sunset to honor those who died as a result of the attack on U.S. military forces in Hawaii. Pearl Harbor Day is not a federal holiday – government offices, schools, and businesses do not close. Some organizations may hold special events in memory of those killed or injured at Pearl Harbor "



<u>Wreaths Across America</u> is a nonprofit organization founded in 2007, dedicated to honoring veterans by placing wreaths on their graves during the holiday season. Each December on National Wreaths Across America Day volunteers gather at over 5,200 locations across the US and abroad to Remember, Honor, and Teach about the sacrifices made by veterans. This year, the event will take place on December 13th. You can get involved by sponsoring a wreath or participating in local ceremonies.
