November 15—District Meeting in Interlachen, breakfast at 9, meeting at 10, please plan to attend.


December 6—Breakfast with Santa, more details next month.

The U.S. Navy's 250th birthday will be celebrated on October 13, 2025

On October 13, 1775, the United States Navy was established. The day is celebrated as the birthdate of the American Navy.

#### **Naval Celebration**

The day is mainly celebrated by personnel, veterans, or other people related to the Navy. Usually, it is marked with a Navy Birthday Ball with a formal dinner, birthday cake, and entertainment. *Join us in the canteen at 6PM for a birthday toast!!!* 

#### Pirate Problem

The United States Navy originated over 240 years ago as the Continental Navy. The then Continental Congress authorized 2 armed vessels to search for ships supplying the British army with weapons and ammunition during the American Revolutionary War (1775–1783).


When the war ended, the Continental Navy was dismantled, but pirate threats to American merchant shipping led President George Washington to establish the Naval Act of 1794, creating a permanent standing US Navy.

# US Navy Today

The United States Navy is the naval warfare branch of the US Armed Forces. It has more than 300,000 personnel on active duty and around 100,000 personnel in the Navy Reserve.

# Navy Day

What is the difference between Navy Day and the <u>Navy Birthday</u>? Both occur in the month of October, and both celebrate the men and women of the United States Navy, past and present. The Navy celebrates its birthday officially on Oct. 13, and Navy Day was established to be observed on Oct. 27.



This year Navy Day will be on Monday, Oct. 27, 2025.

There are plenty of differences between the two, starting with the fact that the Navy Birthday is recognized on the anniversary of the historical formation of the Continental Navy during the American Revolution. Navy Day was originally chosen to coincide with the birthday of President Theodore Roosevelt.

#### Which Came First?

Navy Day is actually the older observance, in terms of when it was created and officially recognized as it is today. The "official" observation of the Navy birthday was initiated by Admiral Elmo Zumwalt in 1972, but Navy Day was sponsored by the Navy League of New York in 1922.

While both <u>holidays</u> recognize the service and sacrifices of those in uniform, Navy Day is specifically about military service, where the Navy birthday celebrates the origins and history of the U.S. Navy.

Navy Day isn't unique to the American military. Many countries worldwide celebrate their own versions on different dates and with different traditions. Russia, Turkey, Pakistan, the United Kingdom, India, Croatia, Mexico, and many other nations all hold their own observations.
