The **United States Army** (**USA**) is the <u>land service</u> branch of the <u>United States Armed Forces</u>. The Army is the oldest branch of the U.S. military and the most senior in order of precedence. It has its roots in the <u>Continental Army</u>, which was formed on 14 June 1775 to fight against the British for independence during the <u>American Revolutionary War</u> (1775–1783). It is the largest military branch. The mission of the U.S. Army is "to fight and win our Nation's wars, by providing prompt, sustained land dominance, across the full range of military operations." The branch participates in conflicts worldwide and is the major ground-based offensive and defensive force of the United States of America. Before



1933, members of the Army National Guard were considered state militia until they were mobilized into the U.S. Army, typically on the onset of war. Since the 1933 amendment to the <u>National Defense Act of 1916</u>, all Army National Guard soldiers have held dual status. They serve as National Guardsmen under the authority of the governor of their state or territory and as reserve members of the U.S. Army under the authority of the president, in the Army National Guard of the United States.

Since the adoption of the total force policy, in the aftermath of the Vietnam War, reserve component soldiers have taken a more active role in U.S. military operations. For example, Reserve and Guard units took part in the <u>Gulf War</u>, peacekeeping in <u>Kosovo</u>, Afghanistan, and the <u>2003 invasion of Iraq</u>.
