






# The Navy Birthday & Navy Day

The US Navy celebrates it's founding on October 13th, 1775 by the Continental Congress when two warships were purchased to attack British ships. During the revolutionary war approximately 20 ships were active at its maximum strength. In 1972 Admiral Zumwalt authorized recognition of 13 October as the Navy's Birthday and he intended it to be an internal activity for members of the active forces, reserves, and retirees. This date is used to encourage a Navy-wide celebration "to enhance a greater appreciation of our Navy heritage and professionalism".

Navy Day was sponsored by the Navy League in 1922 and designed to give recognition to the naval service. October 27th was chosen in order to honor President Theodore Roosevelt who had been born on that date.
