The email below is from DBPR so we can now serve alcohol in our Posts **except** those Posts still in phase 1 or those Posts under suspension.

BUT – we must follow all the Phase 2 guidelines the same as restaurants.

From the State of Florida DBPR to Commander Glen Tilley

"With that being said, and after further discussions with our team and the Secretary, we agree that after further review of the Order, we have ascertained that since private social clubs, lodges, fraternal groups, benevolent associations, American Legions, and VFWs are exempt from the definition of "Public food service establishment" in 509.013(5)(b), F.S., and are therefore ineligible to apply for a food service license from our Division of Hotels and Restaurants, section 1) of DBPR Amended Emergency Order 2020-09 shall NOT apply to your organizations. DBPR will classify you under Section 2) of the order permitting you to open and operate as a restaurant with the ability to sell and serve alcohol for consumption on premises. Please note that you must still subscribe to those delineated provisions and are allowed to open under the temporary "restaurant" guidelines, as defined in Executive Order 20-68, 20-71, 20-112, 20-139, and 20-192.
